



Noteworthy Auditions

Auditions will be held **Friday, September 7** at **6PM** in **E-400** of the **HFAC** (unless otherwise notified).

Sign-up sheets will be located outside of E-400 beginning at 12 noon on September 7th.

Auditions will be in 12 minute time slots and will be held with 3-4 girls at a time. Please come warmed up and ready to sing.

Auditions include:

- Warm-up range test (this will be done in a group) to determine your vocal range.
- 60 second a cappella solo in a style of your choice. Please choose something contemporary, not classical, that best suits your vocal style.
- Part singing from the hymn book. Expect to be asked to sight read the tenor, alto, and soprano parts in range.

Call-backs will be held on **Saturday, September 8th** at **10AM** in **E400** of the **HFAC**. Call-backs will involve learning selections of several songs and learning and performing choreography.

We have 3 slots open this year. We are looking for every voice part, in particular: vocal percussion, low voices (bass) and high voices (soprano).

We're expecting some great talent this year, so please come prepared and ready to perform. We're looking forward to seeing all of you!

Requirements for the group:

- You must be a full-time female BYU student.
- You must be willing to commit to 9 hours of rehearsal a week, plus gigs.
- Must be willing to commit to TWO full semesters, Fall and Winter, and possibly Spring semester.
- Hard-working, positive attitude and committed to upholding the standards of BYU and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.
- This year's group will be involved in:
 - Two semester retreats
 - A Fall headlining show and a Winter joint show with Vocal Point
 - Possible tour to Oregon to sing with UO Divisi and Las Vegas for the A Cappella Summit
 - Various gigs on and off campus
 - Possible submission into the International Competition of Collegiate A Cappella
 - Recording tracks for the 2008/2009 release of Noteworthy's second album
- A chance to develop singing and dancing skills, arrange music and further Noteworthy's goals on campus and in the a cappella community
